
Child Safeguarding Practice Review Flowchart





BHSCP holds extraordinary meeting to agree final report and devise response/ action plan

The BHSCP Business Manager sends a copy of the full report to the Panel and to the Secretary of State no later than seven working days before the date of publication.

Local child safeguarding practice review is published and readily accessible for minimum of 12 months. In addition as part of the report or in a separate document the BHSCP will publish information on:

- Actions that have already been taken in response to the review findings
- the impact of any implemented actions on improving services, and -

interest anticipated.

Action Plan Implemented and progress monitored by the Case Review Group. Regular progress reports to BHSCP.

On the morning of publication the family receive a copy of the final report.

> If child has died the BHSCP Business Manager will send copy of published report to CDOP

There will be instances where a local review has been carried out which could then form part of a thematic national review that the Panel undertakes at a later date.
