We are happy to help with access to relevant learning materials

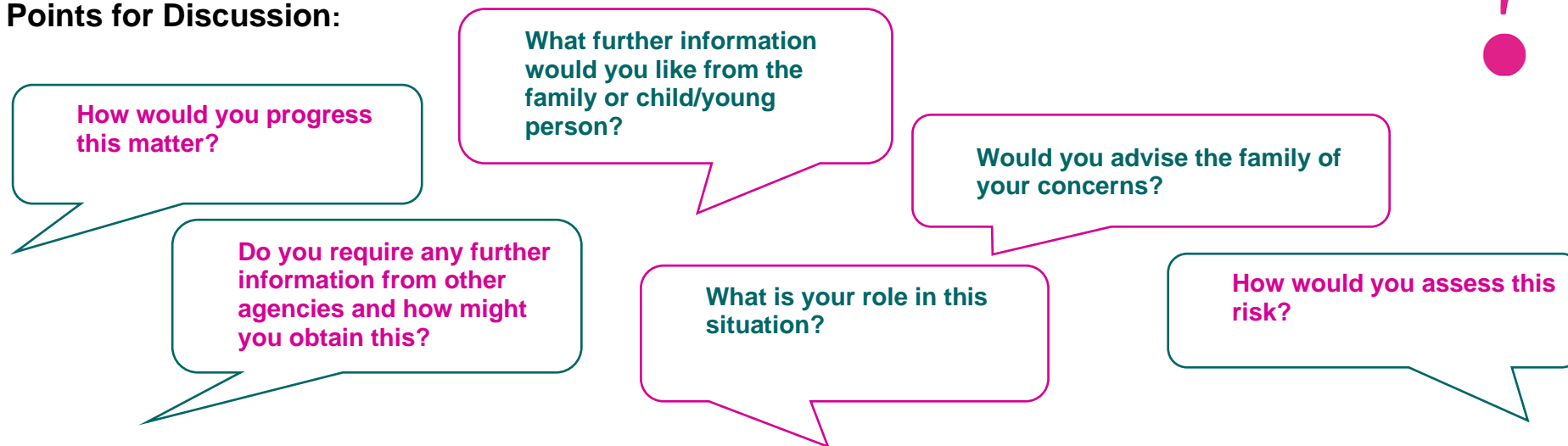
Consider the following question and discuss.....
