We encourage responses to be included in your team minutes and forwarded to the safeguarding lead within your organisation.


We hope that this is a way in which frontline staff across the city can explore some areas of learning without the need to attend formal training. It should also highlight areas of further learning.

A 6yr old child that you work with, has been reported as having linear type bruising to his back. When you speak to him, he says that his mother did it with ruler. He also indicates that he has been asked to touch his mother, "in places that make him feel uncomfortable" and that she touches him.
